




WARNING NOTICES

- Don't let the rope snap back. If the rope is retracted freely, this may lead to injuries (whiplash effect) and the device may be damaged. Caution when unhooking and retracting the rope into the sensor.
- Never exceed the specified measurement range when extracting the rope!
- Do not touch the rope when operating the sensor.
- Avoid guiding the rope over edges or corners. Use a deflection pulley instead.
- Do not operate the sensor if the rope is buckled or damaged. A ripping of the rope may lead to injuries or a damaging of the sensor.
- Do not oil or grease the entire wire pull system.
- Do not pull the measuring wire at an angle.
- Attach the measuring cable retracted to the object to be measured.
- Do not try to open the device. The stored energy of the spring drive may lead to injuries when being mishandled.
- A tensioned measuring cable can lead to injuries in the area where operating personnel are present.
- Do not damage the measuring wire.
- Draw-wire displacement sensors are used for displacement and displacement measurement or position detection of components or moving machine components.
- The sensor may only be operated within the values specified in the technical data.
- The sensor must be used in such a way that no persons are endangered or machines and other material goods are damaged in the event of malfunction or total failure of the sensor.



SZG78 Enoder mounting

- Fix the coupling half to the encoder shaft.
- Mount the flange to the encoder.
- Mount the encoder/flange group to the mechanics of the cable wire system.
- Ensure that the measuring cable is always tensioned by the spring motor, to prevent the measuring cable from jumping off the cable drum.
- The encoder shaft must not be rotated during installation. Observe the relevant encoder mounting instructions.
- · Suitable for mounting are all WDGI-/WDGP-/WDGNor WDGA-58A-06-AIX encoder.



Mounting draw-wire system

- Mounting through mounting holes for 3x M3 screws.
- We do not prescribe any particular sensor orientation
- Select the installation position in such a way that damage to and contamination of the measuring cable is prevented.
- If possible, favour an installation position with the measuring cable outlet facing downwards. This prevents liquids from penetrating the measuring cable outlet.
- Do not twist the measuring cable!
- Only pull out the measuring cable when the sensor is fitted.
- Attach the measuring cable to the measurement object using an eyelet.
- If the measuring cable cannot be guided vertically out of the housing, a deflection pulley must be used.
- Guide the measuring cable in a protected area so that it cannot get caught or damaged.
